A surviving 16th-century record for Eyke and Bromeswell itemises payments for Fleeces, Cunny money, Foldage and Geese – payable at Michaelmas and Lammas. A century later during the Interregnum all records were written in English.

They knew what to seize, namely court rolls and rentals. The documents were carried out of the Priory's jurisdiction to Hollesley where they were burnt. Fortunately for us they failed to seize the court roll of Tangham, begun in 1377 (p.158). In it the incident was subsequently recorded, as was the punishment. Needless to say, all the men's lands, goods and chattels were

confiscated. Five years later the canon, Walter Baa, who was Receiver of Rents for the Priory, summoned the whole 'homage' (landholders) to help him compile a new register of the services and customs of the Manor of Boyton. This, too, has survived.

In 1538 the greatest redistribution of land since the Norman Conquest occurred when all over the country monasteries were closed

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, Anne filie Johnis myddow Duke of Cleve
 to all whome these shal come greeting in Christ evermore
 Wherfore we commaund you that you shal paye unto the King's grace
 the sum of four hundred poundes lawfull money of England
 the first day of June next commynge the first court of a manorial lord
 and on this occasion eight names are inscribed after the preamble. The third, John Medowe, had earlier received the surrender of John Egleston's land, appearing as 'John Myddow' later in the chapter.
