

Postscript

The refectory building has lost its original decoration both inside and out.

A single badly damaged carved block projects from the south-west angle of the former cloister. It is the remains of a finely carved gargoyle. An eyebrow and bulbous eyeball with a pierced pupil can be made out. Rainwater from the refectory would have drained through its mouth on to the cloister roof below. (*Photo: Valerie Fenwick*)
