 2 small stools, a pair of Cobirons, a firepan  
 and a pair of Tongs 30s  
 A Window Cushion 10s

In the kitchen

5 spits, 2 dripping pans, 1 frying pan, 2 gridirons,  
 3 hakes with an Iron to hang them on, an iron grate  
 to boil on, 2 pair of pothooks, a butcher's axe  
 and a Cleaver 40s

 from a bar in the chimney; skillet – cooking pan with 3 feet  
 and a long handle; copper – large tank of this material;  
 bread grate – grater; kettle – two-handled open cooking  
 pot; sestenn – cistern]*

In the upper larder

2 tables, 2 moulds and a keep, a pair of mustard  
 querns, & 4 shelves 13s 4d  
 1 Copper kettle 5s  
 1 oyster drag 3s  
*[moulds – decoratively shaped food was popular; querns –  
 stones used for grinding by hand; keep – small cupboard;  
 drag – trawl net]*

In the nether larder

2 salting keelers, a stool, 2 planks and certain other  
 things 13s 4d  
*[salting keeler – large pan in which coarse salt was rubbed  
 into joints of meat to preserve them]*

In the storehouse

1 stool with 4 feet, & certain of meal tubs & certain  
 old casks & an old hutch 4s  
 2 long shelves, 2 Wicker baskets, 2 flaskets &  
 a little maund, 3 vinegar bottles, 4 water glasses,  
 4 pipkins 4s  
 2 killets 2s  
 77 pieces of pewter, small & great 53s 4d  
*[hutch – chest or cupboard; flasket – long shallow basket;  
 maund – basket; pipkin – handled small earthenware pot;  
 killet – for 'skillet']*

In the Washing house

2 kettles, 1 standing keeler, a trivet to set on a kettle  
 & 2 cobirons 20s  
*[clearly heating water in front of an open fire was the  
 main task; trivet – 3-legged metal stand]*

In the backhouse

2 moulding boards, a bran Tub, a bread slaskett,  
 2 boulting hutches & a minging trough 10s  
 1 Cistern of lead standing in the yard [blank]  
*[moulding board – for shaping loaves upon; boulting  
 hutch – chest for storing sifted flour; minging trough –  
 mingling trough for kneeding dough]*

In the brew house

1 Copper & the mashing vat, the Sweet Wort vat,  
 the keeler, the gildvat, 2 flets, the Dall,  
 8 hogsheads, 3 beer stalls, 7 keelers &  
 certain small vessels £13 6s 8d  
*[mashing vat – for malt mixed with hot water; sweet wort –  
 infusion of malt, before hops are added; flet – skimmer;  
 dall – stone slab]*

In the Taylor's Chamber

1 livery bedstead, a feather bed, a bolster, a pair of  
 blankets & a Coverlet 30s

In the Chamber under the Taylor's Chamber

A livery bedstead, a feather bed, a bolster, a pair of  
 blankets & a Coverlet 30s

In another servingman's Chamber

1 livery bedstead, 1 feather bed, a bolster, a coverlet  
 & a blanket 30s

In the falconer's Chamber & one other Chamber

2 livery beds, 2 feather beds, 2 bolsters, 2 Coverlets,  
 & 3 blankets 53s 4d

In the fremason's chamber

1 livery bedstead, a feather bed and a bolster 20s

In the hopman's Chamber

A livery bedstead, a flock bed, a Coverlet  
 & a blanket 26s

In the gatehouse Chamber

15 planks & 4 loads of freestone 40s

In the Chamber in the gatehouse

1 flock bed, a boarded bedstead & a Coverlet 6s 8d  
 20 loads of freestone in the gatehouse limekiln 40s  
 Another flock bed, a Coverlet & a bolster 3s 4d  
 5 shovels, 2 mattocks, 2 hatchets,  
 & 2 hooks 13s 4d
